What is Missio-Tourism?

Nepal is one of the most beautiful countries in the world, however, it is also one of the darkest countries in the world. It is estimated less than 1 percent of the countries population is Christian. There is a great need for the Gospel in this country and we believe the most effective way to bring a long term Gospel movement to this culture is by empowering local adults to reach the youth in their own community. One of the major obstacles to overcome is the local poverty of Nepal. Nepal suffers from an unemployment rate of 70 percent. This lack of employment forces a large majority of the adults to find work overseas. There is a substantial void left in mentorship, evangelism and discipleship as older Christians move away from their community.

We have developed a micro-enterprise model to help keep youth workers in their community called, *Nepal Outdoor Adventure Treks and Expedition*. Every 10 trekkers that use *Nepal Outdoor Adventure Treks and Expedition* will employ a full-time youth worker in Nepal for a year. This is a Nepalese owned and operated trekking company, however, we need your help to get it off the ground.

The best people to reach a culture are the people of that culture. This micro-enterprise will empower youth workers to stay in their community and reach the next generation of the church. Our goal is to equip and encourage these amazing people as they reach their own culture.
